1 Sunnyside Retail Shopping and Dining

This moderately-sized retail strip on Monterey Blvd is located conveniently within a few blocks of the property. It includes a good selection of restaurants, as well as a Safeway and a wide variety of hair salon's and spas.

2 Sunnyside Elementary Education

This is the attendance area school for 15 Hazelwood. It is highly sought-after and respected for its excellent academics. It has also been recognized as a California Distinguished School by the California Department of Education.

3 Sunnyside Rec Center Parks and Recreation

This park and recreation center features a playground, outdoor tennis and basketball courts, as well as a large grassy area perfect for picnic.

4 Glen Canyon Park Parks and Recreation

Glen Park Recreation Center includes a recently renovated indoor rec center with rock climbing wall, basketball courts, outdoor tennis courts and, sports fields, diamonds, and a playground. The park boasts dramatic geology and hiking trails.

5 Glen Park Village & BART Shopping and Dining

Charming enclave of high quality restaurants and shops, as well as access to major BART and Muni lines. Stop at Destination Baking Company for a slice of pie or at Canyon Market for a local produce.

6 Balboa Park Parks and Recreation

At over 100 years old, this charming park has a wide selection of recreation options, including a recently renovated indoor pool, multiple athletic fields, a skate park, playground, and San Francisco's only soccer-specific stadium.

7 Balboa Park Station Transportation

Located just down Ocean Avenue, This is your go-to transportation hub for quick access downtown San Francisco or the Peninsula. Includes major BART lines as well as access to K, L, M Muni train lines.

8 Lick-Wilmerding High Education

Located within a mile of the property, Lick-Wilmerding is a nationally renowned private high school with small class size and elite academics. It is ranked amongst the top 20 private high schools in California by Niche.com.

9 SF City College Education

12 Aptos Middle School Education

14 Stonestown Galleria Shopping and Dining

15 Sigmund Stern Grove Parks and Recreation
